




















In Focus Romance Scams



Warning Signs

- •Moving quickly: Confessions of strong feelings within a short time of meeting the person
- •Personal troubles, that can be solved with money: Requests for money: You should be wary of any request for money. Block and report them
- •Changes in communication style: If there are several scammers taking turns to maintain the relationship, their writing styles may change
- •Be wary if they're hesitant about meeting: If a new romantic contact is not willing to meet up or talk via video call, or 'long distance eg oil rig worker be cautious
- •Reverse image search: You can check if the images they've sent you are being used publicly online



You lose control once you post anything online
